Lymphedema

Do you have lymphedema or do you know someone who has had lymphedema? Do you know what lymphedema is? Wikipedia states that "lymphedema is a condition of localized swelling caused by a compromised lymphatic system. The lymphatic system functions as a critical portion of the body's immune system and returns interstitial fluid to the blood-stream." If you have had breast cancer surgery, either a lumpectomy or a mastectomy, you are at risk for lymphedema. When you have either of these surgeries lymph nodes are removed to see if your cancer has moved into and through your lymphatic system.

Your lymphatic system functions as a critical portion of the body's immune system. When lymph nodes are removed it can disrupt the movement of fluid through the lymphatic system causing swelling of the arm. Not everyone that has had lymph nodes removed will get lymphedema, but it does not mean you cannot develop it. It can show up years later. Always remember when getting shots or having your blood pressure taken to have it taken in the opposite arm. Protect your arm, try not to carry heavy items with that arm and protect your arm from cuts and insect bites to cut down on infections.

While there is no cure for lymphedema, there are several ways to move the fluid and reduce swelling. A trained physical therapist can help move the fluid out of your arm and show you exercises that will help in keeping the swelling down. You can also be measured for a compression garment (sleeve) that will help push the fluid out of the arm back into the body.

Always remember to take care of yourself. Get to a healthy weight, eat healthy, choose whole-grain foods instead of white floor and sugar. Cut back on red meat and processed meats and limit alcohol if you drink. Don't forget to exercise and try to get a good nights sleep!

No further business, motion made by Jimmy and seconded by Linda that meeting be adjourned.






